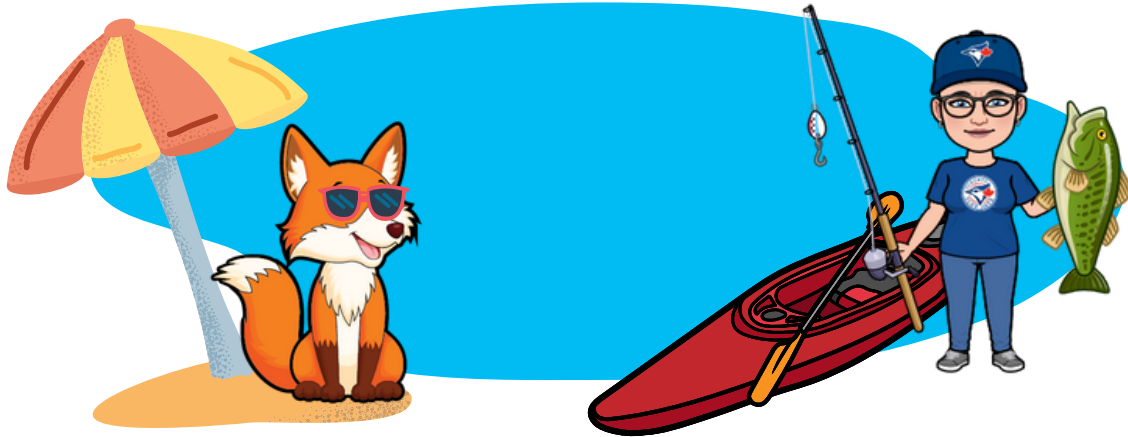




June Newsletter

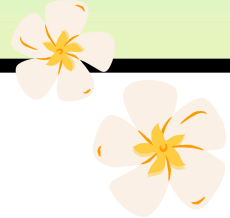

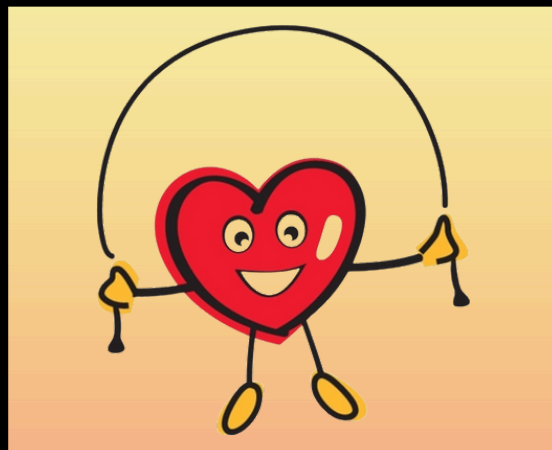


