2025-2026 New and Returning Student Registration Opened **February 3rd**

Prairie Rose uses an online registration system called *School Engage* for annual student registrations. When you receive the email to complete 2025-2026 Returning PRPS Student Registration Form, you will be required to log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal account [Parent Sign In \(prsd8.ca\)](https://prsd8.ca) to complete the registration.

Helpful Hint : It is optimal to complete the forms on a laptop, computer or Chromebook as the menu bar where School Engage is located will automatically open.

Helpful Hint : If you are doing it on a phone, you cannot use the PowerSchool app. It has to be a browser such as Safari or Google. Once you log into PowerSchool look for the small arrow in the grey area on the left side of the screen under your child's name. You will need to expand this to find School Engage.
