

**Attention: Redcliff Schools Staff and Parents**

*Parent Update - Sept 28, 2023*

As was shared with you this past spring, Prairie Rose Public Schools was fortunate to have received design funding for our Redcliff Solution Capital Plan Project. When the funding was announced there were still many unknowns about what the project would look like and which Redcliff schools would be impacted by the modernization project.

Since that time we have learned that Alberta Infrastructure would be taking the lead on the design stage of the project and that GEC Architects out of Calgary had been awarded the design contract. Prairie Rose staff and trustees also met with members of Redcliff Town Council, school councils and received informal feedback from the Redcliff community members. Based on this feedback, it became apparent that the preferred solution for residents was to keep the grade configurations and schools as they were in Redcliff and focus entirely on improving Parkside Jr High School (7-9).

With the modernization of Parkside Jr High School now identified as the sole focus of the Redcliff project, we have set up a webpage where parents, staff, students and community members can get the most current updates about the project. We have also included a FAQ section with some of the more commonly asked questions. This page will be updated on a regular basis when new information about the project becomes available. We will also be sending out a survey at the beginning of October asking our Redcliff community to provide feedback on facility improvements and improved functionality in a renovated Parkside School facility.
