Creative Ventures:

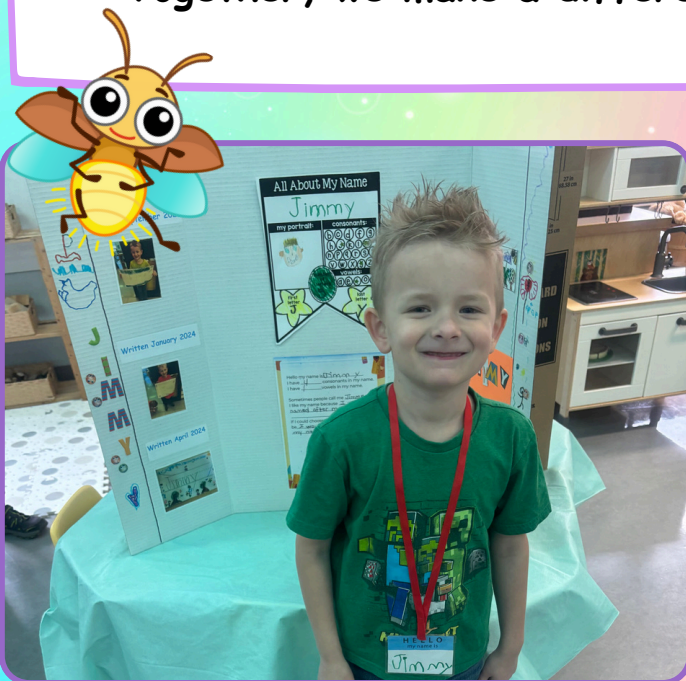

Together, we make a difference in the lives of our students.



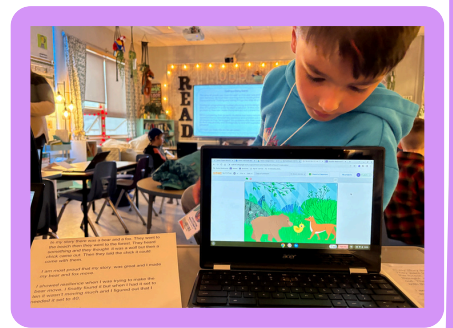
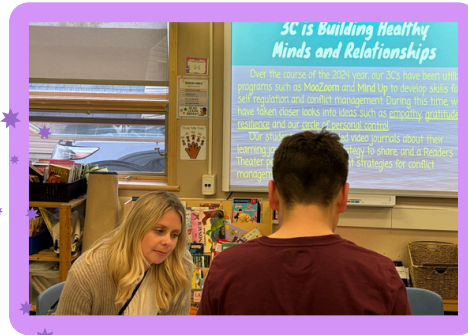
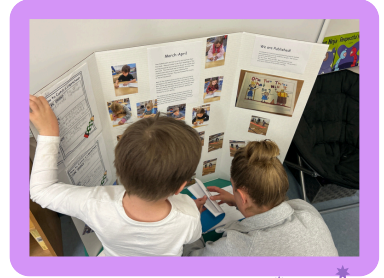
